### ADRODDIAD SCAA SBAR REPORT

#### Sefyllfa / Situation

This report is presented to the Health and Safety Committee (HSC) to provide an update on progress being made against the recommendations highlighted within the Security Management Review paper reported to the HSC on the 11 September 2023

## Cefndir / Background

The previous security update report was presented to the Health and Safety Committee on the 11 September 2023. The Committee requested an action plan detailing progress, timeline, and identified lead against specific actions for the 13 November 2023 meeting and this can be found attached to this report.

#### Asesiad / Assessment

Corporate risk1328 assessment has been updated to reflect the current threat and vulnerabilities facing the organisation and has a risk score of 20. The lack of progress in some areas as highlighted in the security management action plan has contributed to the score increase.

An allocation of £100k has been released to the Digital Team to begin the work on connecting the CCTV cameras installed at Emergency Departments, Minor Injuries and Clinical Decision Units.

The new CCTV cameras for Emergency Departments, Minor Injuries have been connected as a prioritised phased approach and will be operational in December 2023.

The Security Adviser has developed and is promoting the use of guidance that will be accessible at all CCTV recording devices. This is to ensure the correct Information Governance (IG) arrangements are followed each time footage is viewed or downloaded.

The Security Adviser is making progress with the following work streams/projects - Bronglais Hospital Tenovus Unit and Crosshands' Intergrated Care Centre. The Security Adviser has formulated a Physical Security Risk Assessment which is being used to enhance security arrangements across HDdUHB: As well as supporting HDdUHB public Board meetings held at the S4C building, following potential public disorder.

A meeting with Senior Officers of Dyfed Powys Police and the Health Board representatives has recently taken place and following its success will become a regular occurrence.
