Wellbeing Assessment



Population Assessment

- Research and Development Unit in the Health Board (HB) leading on assessment
- In line with statutory requirements, the assessment is looking at needs for care and support across a range of population groups and the extent to which these are being met
- Core data sets prepared for each group, drawing on previous data and updated sets where available
- Engagement with stakeholders at an advanced stage, testing data and identifying additional issues and challenges including impact of Covid-19 and resulting pressures
- Engagement with citizens and users via stakeholder groups and through a generic survey which will be launched in the next week
- Drafting and further interaction with stakeholder groups from late October 2021 to mid
 December 2021
- Sign-off at Regional Partnership Board in January and then by each partner agency in advance of March 2022 publication date

Vest Wales Care Partnership

Market Stability Report

- Being undertaken by Institute of Public Care in liaison with partners, commissioners and providers
- Methodology to test sufficiency and stability is constructed around on-line survey to all regulated providers, analysis of national, regional and organisational data and semi-structured interviews and focus groups of commissioners and providers
- Assessment will be through lens of quality, trends, current and anticipated challenges, commissioning practice and Welsh language provision
- Work on older people's care homes complete, methodology being rolled out to other areas
- Report due by December 2021



Wellbeing Assessments

- Regional survey closed on 8 October 2021 and analysis has begun in each county
- Total responses 1,333 (Carmarthenshire 609, Ceredigion 405, Pembrokeshire 319)
- Low response from young people addressed through separate youth survey
- Engagement events to be concluded by 22 October 2021 targeting hard to reach groups and those under-represented in the survey
- Draft Assessment reports have been started in each county and will be presented to Public Services Boards (PSBs) late November 2021/ early December 2021.
- Work has begun on creating a plan for consultation of the draft assessments with the public
- Aim is for each county to have consulted and amended the reports for the PSBs to sign off in meetings before the start of purdah
- Continued interface with Population Assessment process to ensure consistency and sharing of relevant data and intelligence

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
