## Sefyllfa / Situation

Although there were no requests for the establishment of a new charitable fund received during this reporting period, feedback was provided to members from the CFC meeting held on 28 November 2022.

Members were advised that concerns were raised by the CFC regarding the CFSC's decision to approve a request to create a new charitable fund for the adult Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) service within the Mental Health and Learning Disabilities (MHLD) Directorate. Although the request had been approved by the CFSC, CFC members did not agree with the rationale for the request due to the limited focus of the fund. It was also felt that the request for the new fund did not align with the CFC's objective of streamlining funds to move to a structure where more 'general' funds are created to offer services more flexibility on how charitable donations can be used.
