Asesiad / Assessment

Justifications for the extensions to the review dates of the policies are detailed below. The extension dates have been determined by the lead officers and assurance has been provided by the lead authors that the documents remain fit for purpose during the extension period.

Due to staff capacity issues within the operational compliance team, a selection of operational policies were unable to be reviewed within the agreed timelines, as a consequence of this, an extension of time is being sought.
