ADRODDIAD SCAA SBAR REPORT

Sefyllfa / Situation

This report provides an update to the Health and Safety Committee (HSC) with regard to progress in managing the following areas of Fire Safety:

- Fire Enforcement Notices (FENs)/Letters of Fire Safety Matters (LoFSM)
- Fire Safety Management
- Fire Safety Governance

Cefndir / Background

The HSC will recall previous updates on each of the above. This report provides an update on progress on each of these areas since the previous HSC Meeting held on 9th January 2023.

Asesiad / Assessment

- 1. Fire Enforcement Notices (FENs)/Letters of Fire Safety Matters (LoFSMs)
- 1.1 Withybush General Hospital (WGH)

Phase 1

All remaining horizontal escape routes at WGH, all remaining work at St Caradogs and St Nons, all work at Kensington, St Thomas, Springfield, Sealyham, and Pembroke County Blocks (FEN KS/890/03, FEN KS/890/05 and LOFSM completion date April 2022) (Currently extended to March 2023).

The completion date for the Phase 1 project at WGH remains on programme for end of July 2023. This is the current programme date but given the complexity of the project this is being closely managed and we will update on any future changes.

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The Mid and West Wales Fire and Rescue Service (MWWFRS) have noted that they will look to revisit the HDdUHB prior to the current proposed end date for this FEN (March 2023) so that an appropriate extension can be considered at that point.

The financial position remains challenging and has recently been reported to the Capital Sub Committee (CSC).

Phase 2

All departments/ ward areas/ risk rooms (FEN KS/890/04) (Current date April 2025).

At the last Committee meeting the programme date for completing the Business Justification Case (BJC) was noted as Quarter 4 of the 2022/23 financial year (FY).

As part of the development of the Phase 2 BJC the initial outturn capital cost forecast has raised concerns in terms of the level of capital expenditure required for the Phase 2 work.

These concerns have been communicated to the Director of Operations within the HDdUHB and also to NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership (NWSSP), Welsh Government (WG) and MWWFRS.

We are working closely with NWSSP – Senior Fire Safety Advisor in reviewing the full scope of this contract and to understand where reductions and efficiencies can be made.

Working in partnership with NWSSP we have already commenced this work with the Supply Chain Partner (SCP) to give a greater clarity on the cost of individual elements of work. We will then have a sound evidence base which we can use to make reductions to the scope of the scheme whilst still maintaining the full support of MWWFRS in achieving compliance with the Enforcement Notice.

We expect to have clarity on the financial elements on the current scope of work by the end of March 2023.

The next step will be to meet with MWWFRS with the full support of NWSSP in establishing the most appropriate way forward for Phase 2 work. At this point we will need to re-engage with WG to consider the revised scope of project and financial envelope.

Given the above additional analysis and the need to meet again with WG and MWWFRS to establish the revised approach it is anticipated that this will take a further 4 months than originally planned. It is difficult at this point to be specific on this and we will of course try to accelerate this where possible.

We have already discussed the above approach with MWWFRS who are fully committed to working with us.

It is important to note that the Phase 2 completion date is currently April 2025. MWWFRS are fully satisfied with progress on Phase 1 and also on the work progressing on the Decant Ward at WGH which will be operational circa January 2024.

In discussion with WG they have also raised the question of the future of WGH given the link to A Healthier Mid and West Wales and future repurposing. The current timeline for this is in the order of 7 years so they are understandably interested in the levels of investment being made

into older Estate with potentially limited lifespan. This discussion has also involved the future major infrastructure investment and how this can be shaped to support this programme.

Decant Arrangements to Support Phase 2 Work

As noted at the previous Committee this project is fully approved to proceed in the sum of £8.313m.

It is expected that site works will commence circa April 2023 and completion date remains on target for the Ward to be operational by January 2024.

Noting this timeline and the link to Phase 2 programme we remain confident of continuing progress within a timeline which is acceptable to MWWFRS. We remain in regular contact with the Fire Service in a partnership approach to this process.

1.2 Glangwili General Hospital (GGH)

Phase 1

All remaining horizontal escape routes at GGH (FEN KS/890/08 Completion Date July 2022) (Currently extended to February 2023).

The completion date for the Phase 1 project at GGH remains on programme for November 2023.

MWWFRS plan to visit the site towards the end Feb 23 prior to the current proposed end date for this FEN) so that an appropriate extension can be considered at that point.

Phase 2

All departments/ ward areas/ risk rooms (FEN KS/890/09) (Current date August 2024).

As noted at the previous Committee the completion date for the Phase 2 BJC is programmed to be August 2023. Whilst this remains the current programme, we are mindful of the additional challenges being experienced on WGH Phase 2 which we will now be considering with the SCP as this BJC progresses.

MWWFRS have been fully briefed on this and are supportive, noting the good progress on Phase 1.

It is important to note that Phase 2 works will be extremely complex given the delivery of these FEN works to busy clinical areas. The due diligence work required during Business Case development will confirm both commencement dates and programme delivery dates for this work.

Discussions have been undertaken with MWWFRS, who appreciate that a revision may be required to the FEN dates should the nature of the works dictate that an additional period of time becomes necessary.

1.3 Additional Letters of Fire Safety Matters

Bronglais General Hospital (BGH) Main Building

- The current revised letters issued dated 31 August 2022.
- The LoFSMs have a significant number of requirements, however there is no FEN action placed on HDdUHB for BGH.

As noted in the previous update to the HSC, MWWFRS have revised their LoFSM to align with the forecast delivery plan the HDdUHB has developed.

The HDdUHB has now completed the Programme Business Case (PBC) for BGH main buildings. This is being considered at the February SDODC with a value of circa £29.6m, subject to approval this will then be considered at the Board Meeting in March 2023.

The current expectation is that this will be going to WG in mid-April to commence scrutiny. It should be noted that this is the PBC so is the initial high-level document and, subject to being endorsed by WG, the HDdUHB will be in the position to draw down funds necessary to progress with the BJC at that point. This business case programme currently aligns with the above programme provided previously to MWWFRS.

Further updates to the HSC will be provided as the work continues.

Regular dialogue with MWWFRS and WG continues as these Business Cases are being developed.

BGH Residential Blocks

 All works have been completed and MWWFRS will undertake their visit on 13 March 2023 to sign off these works

Prince Philip Hospital (PPH)

- At the previous Committee it was noted that priority works have been committed to be undertaken in the current financial year and a 3-stage investment plan has been established for future work.
 - The priority advance works are progressing well with expected competition at end March 2023
 - The initial stage of EFAB funding will commence in April 2023 and will continue into the following financial year completing in March 2025 (£411k and £733k respectively)
 - The final stage of Business Case development for the remaining work beyond 2025 will require a BJC to be submitted to WG circa December 2024.

South Pembrokeshire Hospital (SPH)

- A LoFSM has been received for SPH which we included in our bidding process for EFAB funding
- This bid was fully approved, and we now have an established 2 Year programme covering 2023/24 and 2024/25 to address all requirements of the LoFSM. EFAB funding approved at £318k and £485k respectively for the 2 Year programme

As noted in the previous committee we can now give an assurance that all Fire Investment plans for all requirements across the HDdUHB have now been fully approved by MWWFRS and we continue to meet regularly to update on progress.

1.4 Impact on review and/or removal of Welsh Government Funding

The HDdUHB is currently managing live contracts in the order of £40m funded by WG. To date WG have been fully supportive in funding our plans as presented and agreed with MWWFRS.

WG have been clear that each Business Case will need to be considered on its own merits and therefore whilst they are fully briefed on our longer-term delivery programme, they will only consider applications for funding when appropriate business cases are submitted for consideration.

Clearly where we have FENs if future funding was not forthcoming the MWWFRS would be able to prosecute the HDdUHB or ultimately prohibit areas of use. Similarly, where we have LoFSMs, and funding was not made available the MWWFRS would be able to escalate these to FENs.

WG have been fully briefed on this potential in our joint meetings with MWWFRS and understand the implications of any reduction of future funding.

As previously noted, we presented our overall plans on a site-by-site basis to MWWFRS on the 8th December 2022. I have attached at Appendix 1 a letter from MWWFRS to the HDdUHB Chief Executive Officer noting their satisfaction with the information provided and their agreement with the current position of projects being progressed. WG have also been fully aligned with this briefing and with the response received from MWWFRS.

2. Audit Tracker

Attached at Appendix 2 for further information, is the HDdUHB tracker developed by the Assurance and Risk Team which monitors progress on all of the above issues. Going forward, this Appendix will be regularly updated and submitted with the Fire Safety Management Update Report to the Health and Safety Committee for completeness.

3. Fire Safety Management Update

3.1 Fire Risk Assessments (FRAs)

As of 15th February 2023, there are no overdue FRAs. A further 26 FRAs come online (up to 31st March 2023) as identified on the NWSSP-SES system dashboard.

3.2 Boris Fire Risk Assessment Management System

Live Fire Risk Assessments are now being undertaken by using the new system. A full update was given to the Fire Safety Group on 6 December 2022. All fire risk assessments will transfer to the new Boris system over the next circa 12 months. Currently 88 Fire Risk Assessments out of a total of 364 have been undertaken and transferred (24.17% of all FRAs; 12% previously reported).

The team has experienced some system issues in transferring data to the new system which has reduced the transfer percentages in the last few weeks. These issues are currently being resolved and additional administrative resources have been allocated from February 2023.

The original intention was to complete all transfers by Summer 2023, which remains the target; however, progress will need to be revisited when it is understood how the additional resource accelerates the transfer process.

3.3 Fire Safety Training

Performance, in terms of delivery of fire safety training, is identified in tables below.

As noted above:

- Level 1 fire safety training has now achieved 80% for the first time.
- Level 2 fire safety training has increased by 3% from last report. Level 2 training covers all clinical staff that work with or have direct contact with in-patient and outpatient facilities
- Level 3 fire safety training has increased by 5% since the last report. Acknowledging the importance of the training for these individuals, additional sessions have been provided but due to sickness levels and staff pressures, the uptake has not achieved the impact expected. We will continue to undertake additional sessions on a flexible basis to try and bring these percentages up to circa 80% by 1st Quarter of 2023/24.
- Level 4 fire warden training 6 sessions facilitated by an external accredited contractor have taken place with a total number of 92 volunteers being trained. Additional sessions will be provided if more volunteers are forthcoming.
- Level 5 senior staff training (Band 8B & above) 162 staff have already attended the training out of a possible 230. This equates to a 72.61% uptake.

Confidence remains that the required capacity for training within HDdUHB is in place; however, fluctuations in staff attendance continue within Level 2. The pressures on clinical and management teams to attend this training at such challenging times is fully understood. This is the key issue which is preventing significant improvements in fire training statistics.

To escalate this further, as noted in the recent Fire Governance Internal Audit Report, fire training is now formally reported to the Senior Operations Business Meeting to enable the

Director of Operations to give this additional scrutiny. In addition, reports now include Level 4 (Fire Wardens) and Level 5 (Management) training statistics (February 2023 onwards in line with Audit recommendations).

3.4 Unwanted Fire Signals (UwFS)

We have attached as Appendix 3 a full report on UwFS throughout the HDdUHB.

4. Fire Safety Governance Update

The only remaining item is the Fire Safety Policy, which is being presented to this Committee today for approval.

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
