#### ADRODDIAD SCAA SBAR REPORT Sefyllfa / Situation

The Health and Safety Committee is asked to approve a short extension of time to finalise the review of Hywel Dda University Health Board's (HDdUHB) Fire Safety Policy:

Policy No 242 – Fire Safety Policy (Review by 17/12/2022)

Currently seeking a short extension until March 2023.

## Cefndir / Background

It is imperative that HDdUHB has accurate written control documentation in order to comply with relevant legislation/regulations and minimise any risks associated with Fire Safety.

The existing fire safety policy documentation remains fit for purpose. This statement is supported following the outcome of a recent comparison review undertaken across other Health Boards in Wales and content approval provided from NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership - Specialist Estates Services (NWSSP-SES) (senior fire safety advisor).

#### Asesiad / Assessment

Justifications for the short extension of time to the review date of this policy are outlined below.

The proposed extension date (until March 2023) has been determined by the lead officers and assurance has been provided that the review, necessary global consultation and changes will be completed before this date and the document considered for final approval at the March 2023 Health and Safety Committee meeting.

• The Fire Team originally only anticipated minor changes to the policy, which would not require a formal 14 day global consultation. However, on reflection, the changes now being considered would trigger a formal consultation, thus extending the approval timelines.

- The policy has been tabled at the main Fire Safety Group (the owning group for this document) on 6<sup>th</sup> December 2022 and a request for official comments has been made. Due to meeting dates, the responses will not be received in time to be considered for the January 2023 Health and Safety Committee Meeting.
- The Fire Team has made some key changes to the training needs analysis section of the document. This is to update the document regarding new arrangements for the delivery of fire training across the HDdUHB. Final comments from colleagues in Learning and Development are awaited.
