It is imperative that Hywel Dda University Health Board (HDdUHB) has up to date and accurate written control documentation in order to comply with relevant legislation/regulations and minimise any associated risk.

Asesiad / Assessment

Justifications for the extensions to the review dates of the policies are detailed below. The extension dates have been determined by the lead officers and assurance has been provided by the lead authors that the documents remain fit for purpose during the extension period.

761 – Violent Patient Marker Procedure – a full review of this procedure is being undertaken by the Head of Safety and Security and the Violence and Aggression Case Manager. A 6 month extension is requested.

749 – Lockdown Policy - Lockdown capability is being assessed as part of a Security Management review which scope is to make recommendations to the Executive Team and Health Board, and forms part of Planning Objective 3L for completion April 2023. The Lockdown Policy and Hospital Lockdown plans will be reviewed as part of this work. Therefore an extension until the end of April 2023 is requested.
