#### ADRODDIAD SCAA SBAR REPORT <u>Sefyllfa / Situation</u>

The Mid and West Wales Fire and Rescue Service (MWWFRS) have visited both Withybush General Hospital (WGH) and Glangwili General Hospital (GGH) to undertake inspections on Fire Safety.

At WGH a range of Enforcement Notices and Letters of Fire Safety have been issued to the Hywel Dda University Health Board (HDdUHB) indicating the compliance times required for the various elements of work.

At GGH a single Fire Enforcement Notice was received on 20 April 2020.

## Cefndir / Background

In the case of WGH a clear delivery programme has already been established and agreed with MWWFRS. Following the impact of COVID-19 it has been necessary to review and reset this programme.

At GGH we have developed a proposed action plan for this site which does require further consideration and support of both the MWWFRS and Welsh Government (WG).

The approach at GGH will be similar to that of WGH. This will proceed on the basis of a Phased Plan broken down into the following stages:

- Low cost items of improvement
- Vertical escape routes
- Horizontal escape routes
- Departments and Wards

### Asesiad / Assessment

For both of the above programmes, the COVID-19 Pandemic has impacted on delivery timelines, which has now been included in both programmes for consideration.

### <u>WGH</u>

The detailed delivery programme for WGH had been fully agreed with the MWWFRS and supported by WG prior to the COVID-19 Pandemic. This programme has now been reassessed and, with specific advice received from Infection Control teams within the HDdUHB, has been reprogrammed fully.

**Attachment 1** includes both the original programme (agreed with MWWFRS) and the future agreed programme, side by side to clearly demonstrate the impact of COVID-19.

As noted in **Attachment 1** the impact of COVID-19 is a delay in the order of 3 to 4 months. This re-profiling of the programme has been fully agreed with MWWFRS and they are now considering how they reissue the Enforcement Notices to reflect the revised programme. One option being considered is to leave the current notices as they are however issue a covering letter confirming the new programme dates for this work. I understand from discussions with MWWFRS that this is to simply avoid additional unnecessary administration.

#### <u>GGH</u>

The detailed delivery programme for GGH has now been presented to MWWFRS. This programme has been developed with advice from HDdUHB Infection Control Teams.

The MWWFRS have requested a short period to consider this programme and will come back to the HDdUHB for clarification if necessary.

We have agreed that once the MWWFRS are satisfied with the programme we will hold a joint meeting with WG colleagues to confirm that all parties are fully supportive of this plan. This approach to agree all programme dates worked well on the WGH project.

**Attachment 2** outlines the proposed programme for GGH. As you will note from this attachment the work will be phased in a similar way to the WGH approach. Subject to this agreement, the MWWFRS will then consider how they will reissue Enforcement Notices to reflect the agreed timescales for each element of work.

#### Additional assurance on detail contained within all Enforcement Notices/Letters of Fire Safety

In order to provide further assurance on our delivery programme all individual Enforcement Notices/Letter of Fire Safety are tracked on the Health Board system. This system contains each individual recommendation contained within each Notice with specified delivery dates so that we can accurately track that progress is delivered to the plan. Any exceptions to this will be reported as regular updates to this Committee.
