The service is also compliant with the majority of the principles outlined. One variation is the suggestion that ideally a Consultant in Sports and Exercise Medicine forms part of the service leadership team. HDdUHB does not have a Consultant with this title, however, the therapy clinical lead does have the required musculoskeletal experience and skills and has an established partnership with a GP working at Associate Director level. As a result, HDdUHB believes it satisfies this criterion outlined within the guidance. HDdUHB reports performance quarterly to Welsh Government and the National Planned Care Board. The service complies with the metrics including waiting times not exceeding 6 weeks. The final step in meeting full compliance with the WHC was the implementation of electronic referral system. This went live in Jan 2020. It allows electronic referral management, triage and timely communication.
