ADRODDIAD SCAA SBAR REPORT

Sefyllfa / Situation

There are 2 pieces of work that are ongoing regarding stroke service in Hywel Dda:-

1. Stroke Re-design Programme, with an agreement by the Executive Team to initially focus on the short to medium term within the Carmarthenshire area.
2. The collaborative work with Swansea Bay UHB/ARCH in establishing a regional stroke service including a Hyper Acute Stroke Unit.

Cefndir / Background

Over recent months, discussion has restarted in relation to the Stroke Re-design Programme, with an agreement by the Executive Team to initially focus on the short to medium term within the Carmarthenshire area. The rationale for this includes:

- Re-instating the entire re-design programme across the short, medium and long-term (all requiring different solutions) would take in excess of 18-24 months due to the complexity and competing solutions.
- Meetings and work has started with Swansea Bay University Health Board's (SBUHB) regarding the HASU project.
- Short/medium-term medical staffing sustainability concerns for Glangwili General Hospital (GGH), which relies on a single-handed clinician (not started)
- Both Glangwili General Hospital (GGH) and Prince Phillip Hospital (PPH) are struggling to keep up with the national stroke standards.
- The inability to change any stroke provision in Pembrokeshire until the new hospital is built.
- The requirement to maintain stroke services in Ceredigion even when the new hospital is built.

Asesiad / Assessment

During the week commencing 23 May 2022, meetings with both ARCH and SBUHB concluded that some Hywel Dda UHB residents will be provided for in the Morryston Hyperacute Stroke Units (HASU) development and that the ARCH work stream would be re-established as a matter of urgency. Further meetings have been held and work is progressing well, with the business case for the HASU development being progressed. However whilst this development is welcomed, it only covers the HASU element of the stroke pathway and creates further challenge regarding the Carmarthenshire re-design work.

Next steps include agreement on the Hywel Dda catchment area to flow to Morryston and the timeline for the Morryston HASU to be completed as this directly impacts on the requirements for stroke provision within Carmarthenshire.

The stroke leadership team has commenced discussions regarding the Stroke Services in Carmarthenshire with the stroke clinicians, General Manager of the Carmarthenshire Acute Units and the Hospital Directors of both Hospitals GGH and Prince Philip Hospital (PPH). However we have not progressed any further with this plan due to re start of the ARCH programme.

We still believe sustaining two stroke units in Carmarthenshire will be challenging and not sustainable. The Stroke Management Team is currently considering how the woder pathway work can be taken forward.
