Update from Sian-Marie James: October 2023 Following internal discussions and meetings with ARCH colleagues, the Health Board is considering entering into an overarching Memorandum of Understanding with Swansea Bay UHB (and possibly Swansea University) in

				relation to ARCH programmes of work. Internal discussions are continuing. If this is agreed, the MoU would include all programmes, including Orthopaedics. The Project Definition Document (PDD) for regional Orthopaedic services between the Health Board and Swansea Bay UHB is a separate document.
