Y Penderfyniadau a'r Materion a Ystyriodd y Grŵp/ls-Bwyllgor: Key Decisions and Matters Considered by the Group:

- The Estates team is exploring the opportunity to deliver a further Energy Performance Contract (EPC) via the Re:Fit 4 Wales Framework route. The current EPC contract with Centrica is due to end 31st March 2024. A working group has been established to develop and progress a new EPC, commencing with a 'soft tender' exercise in quarter 4 2022/23 to establish interest from the framework providers to work with the Health Board to develop and implement phases of work.
- The Procurement team, where possible, is encouraging participation of local suppliers.
 For example, restricting the geographical coverage of suppliers to either those within the
 Health Board or Wales, when running multi-quote exercises. 'Meet the buyer' events will
 also be set up as part of pre-market engagement on tender exercises to encourage
 participation of local and small to medium-sized enterprise (SME) providers.
- A decarbonisation question is included within all tender events with a 5% weighting. The
 question asks: NHS Wales wishes to reduce the carbon footprint of its supply chains with
 the aim of being net zero carbon by at the latest 2030. Please provide an overview of how
 your organisation is working towards reducing the carbon impact of its activities and
 provide a roadmap detailing how this will progress.
- Newly formed NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership (NWSSP) team, Sustainability & Net Zero Management, will be supporting Procurement and the Decarbonisation Task Force Group going forward;
- The Group continues to develop a range of carbon awareness initiatives, examples include:
 - Development of a 'Sustainability Awareness' video;
 - Launch of intranet 'Sustainability Hub' is live and continues to be developed. The
 Green Health Network page will transfer over the hub, and we will signpost staff to
 resources as they are developed. Once established, there will be a regular staff
 'Sustainability Newsletter'.
 - Green Teams Competition 6 projects submitted and being delivered;
 - Ongoing scoping of opportunities to deliver a carbon awareness programme for public sector options being explored;
