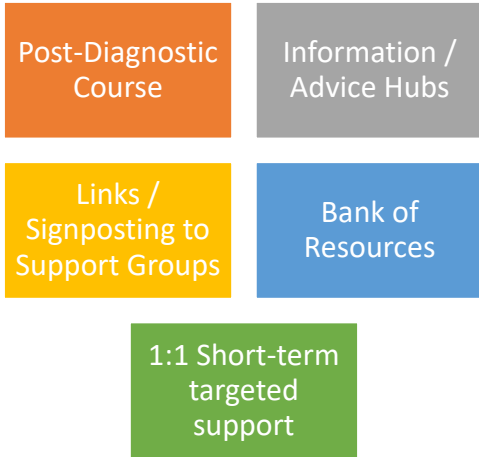

Crisis / Emergency support.

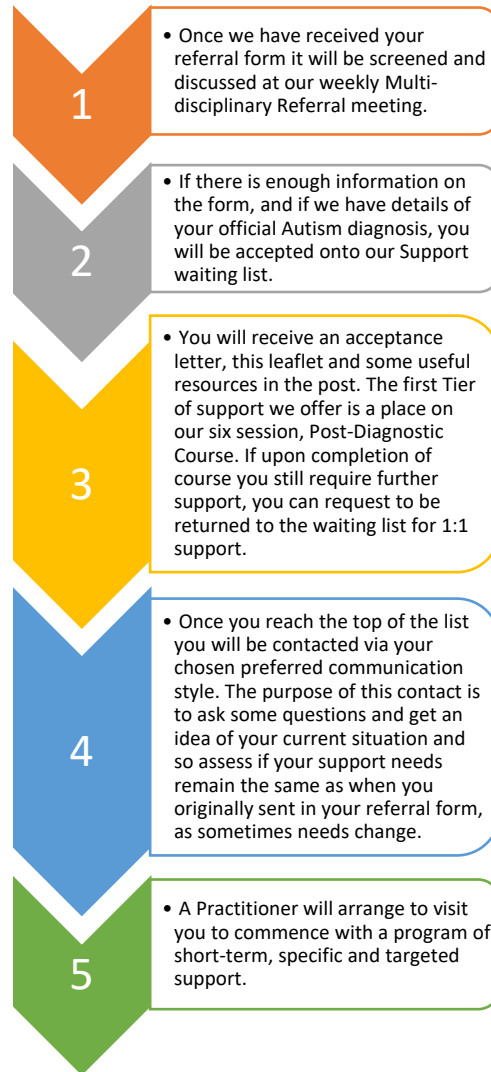
We are a 9:30 – 4:30 pm,
