Please note:- The data provided refers to patients who either had epilepsy at the time of admission or were admitted due to epilepsy. This may not be a complete list of all of the UHB's patients recorded with this diagnosis. Additionally, the data provided may contain duplications if the same patient was admitted more than once during the same period of time.

- 3. The UHB confirms that it has a caseload of three hundred and ninety eight (398) and employs one (1) Whole Time Equivalent (WTE) Agenda for Change (A4C) Band 7 Epilepsy Specialist Nurse (ESN), one (1) WTE A4C Band 6 through Learning Disabilities (LD) and has also appointed one (1) WTE A4C Band 6 who is yet to commence the position.
- 4. The UHB confirms that it does not have a waiting list for adult patients waiting for an appointment with an ESN. However, as soon as a referral is received from the Neurologist, a letter and leaflet is sent to the patient explaining about open access via telephone. All patients and families can telephone the number provided in the information leaflet and will usually receive a response the same day. If not, the Epilepsy Service will endeavour to respond within two (2) to five (5) working days. If a face-to-face appointment is required, one will be planned as appropriate.
