Clarification

To clarify, it's all medical and nursing staff.

Response:

Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) is unable to provide you with all of the information requested, as it is estimated that the cost of answering your request would exceed the "appropriate

limit" as stated in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004. The "appropriate limit" represents the estimated cost of one person spending 18 hours (or $2\frac{1}{2}$ working days) in determining whether the UHB holds the information, and locating, retrieving and extracting the information.

Prior to the 2020/21 financial year, On and Off-framework agency expenditure was not recorded in the financial ledger for question 1. Additionally, for question 3, prior to the 2019/20 financial year, On and Off-framework agency shifts were not recorded in the UHB's E-Rostering systems. Therefore, in order to provide you with all of the data requested for question 1, the UHB would need to interrogate old Finance systems to extract the information requested, identify and split out invoices and cross check with Workforce records. For question 3, the UHB would need to undertake a manual trawl of all systems and invoices to identify the information that would fulfil your request, as this was not recorded centrally at those times.

The UHB is therefore applying an exemption under Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FoIA), which provides an exemption from a public authority's obligation to comply with a request for information where the cost of compliance is estimated to exceed the appropriate limit.

However, under Section 16 of the FoIA, we are required as a public authority, to provide advice and assistance so far as it is reasonable, to individuals who have made a request under the FoIA and therefore, the UHB provides the accessible data below.

1) The UHB provides, within the table below, the spend on Off-framework agency staff for Registered Nurses and Health Care Support Workers (HCSW), during the financial years 2020/21, 2021/22 and 2022/23 to the date of your request.
