<u>Response</u>:

- 1. Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) confirms that the average waiting time for children referred for an Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) assessment was seventy four (74) weeks, as at 29 March 2023.
- 2. The UHB confirms that the average waiting time for adults referred for an ASD assessment was seventy six (76) weeks, as at 29 March 2023.
- 3. The UHB is unable to provide the information exactly as requested as the system used within this service records information in a different format and the data for March is not available at the date of your request. Therefore, the UHB provides, within the table below, the number of children referred for an ADHD assessment and the weeks waiting, as at 28 February 2023.

- 4. The UHB confirms that the average waiting time for adults referred for an ADHD assessment was fifty eight (58) weeks, as at 29 March 2023.
- 5. The UHB confirms that it has a specialist budget allocated for adult and children's ASD and adult ADHD services. The UHB does not have a specialist budget allocated for Dyscalculia, Dyslexia, Dyspraxia/ Developmental Coordination Disorder (DCD) or Tourette's Syndrome; the budget for these specialties are incorporated into the relevant teams' overall budget.
- 6. The UHB provides, within the table below, the budget allocation to each of the adult and children's ASD and adult ADHD services, for the 2023/24 financial year.
