- 3. This information has been provided in response to question 1.
- 4. Cisco provides the UHB's Local Area Network (LAN) infrastructure. However, as the maintenance of this is mainly managed in-house, an annual spend is therefore not held.
- 5. Aruba provides the UHB's WiFi infrastructure. However, as the maintenance of this is managed in-house, an annual spend is therefore not held.
- 6. This information has been provided in response to question 5.

- 7. This information is not held as the original core networks were originally installed during the 1990s.
- 8. Yes, the core network has been updated recently.
- 9. The UHB's core network is maintained by All-Four.
- 10. The contract renewal date is 18 April 2025.
- 11. This information is not held due to the length of time that has passed since the original project.
- 12. The current annual costs for the UHB's core network is £36,700.
