Requested:

Please can you inform me how many DATIX have been completed from S-CAMHS staff over the last year that has been reported for patient aggressive behaviour, and what professional title has reported these?

Response:

Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) is unable to provide you with the information requested, due to the low number of cases (5 and under), as there is a potential risk of identifying individuals if this was disclosed. Therefore, the UHB is withholding these details under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FoIA).

This information is protected by the Data Protection Act 2018 (DPA)/UK General Data Protection Regulations, as its disclosure would constitute unfair and unlawful processing and would be contrary to the principles and articles of the UK GDPR. This exemption is absolute and therefore, there is no requirement to apply the public interest test.

In reaching this decision, the DPA and UK GDPR define personal data as data that relates to a living individual who can be identified solely from that data or from that data and other information, which is in the possession of the data controller.

Additionally, the UHB's Datix Incident Reporting system does not record the job title of the reporter.
