I am able to see the figures you publish online, however these are deaths for any reason within 28 days of a positive COVID test, so may have died from other causes. Therefore I would like to know the exact figures from 1st January 2020 – 1st April 2021 of people who have died due to Covid-19 and not anything else?

- 3. The percentage and number of those without underlying health problems in the overall total?
- 4. The number and percentage of those that have died from Covid-19 in the overall total under the age of 50 years?

Response:
