I write regarding a Freedom of Information request about the suspension of breast cancer screening services during COVID-19 and would be grateful if you could provide me with the following information:

1. How many women were eligible for population breast cancer screening services (i.e. between the ages of 50 and 71) between March 2020 and June 2021?
2. How many women had their breast cancer screening delayed between March 2020 and June 2021?
3. Will you provide a breakdown of delays by month of breast cancer screening services between March 2020 and June 2021?
4. How many breast cancer screening services suspended invitations for population screening in your local health board area during this time and when did they resume invitations?
