- Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) confirms that Day Surgery in Withybush General Hospital (WGH) and the Endoscopy Units in Bronglais General Hospital (BGH), Glangwili General Hospital (GGH) and Prince Philip Hospital (PPH) currently perform flexible cystoscopies for investigatory purposes.
- 2. The UHB provides, within the table below, the approximate number of patients seen in Urology for investigatory flexible cystoscopies, per week, month and year, by hospital, during the 2021 calendar year.
