Requested

- 1. How many inpatients developed food poisoning (relating to E. coli, listeria, campylobacter, salmonella or other) during a stay at the hospitals in your trust between the end of May 2013 and the end of May 2014?
- 2. Are meals prepared on site or off the premises by an outside provider?
- 3. How many complaints did you receive about hospital food between the end of May 2019 and the end of May 2018?
- 4. How many complaints did you receive about hospital food between the end of May 2013 and the end of May 2014?

Response:

- 1. Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) has a record of one patient reporting symptoms of food poisoning whilst an inpatient between the dates set out.
- Glangwili General Hospital, Withybush General Hospital and Bronglais General Hospital prepare meals on site. Prince Philip Hospital and the UHB's smaller in-patient hospital premises have their meals prepared off site.
- 3. Between 31 May 2018 and 31 May 2019, the UHB received five (5) complaints relating to hospital food.
- 4. The UHB does not have a record of receiving any complaints relating to hospital food between 31 May 2013 and 31 May 2014.
