## Requested:

- 1. How many branch surgery closure applications has the Health Board received in the last five years, from January 2017-January 2022?
- 2. Of the total number, how many applications have been made by independent GP contractor Practices and how many have been requests to close Health Board Managed Practices?
- 3. How many applications have been approved and how many Health Board owned Branch surgery closures have been approved?
- 4. Has there been a different process for Health Board owned Practices?
- 5. For a Hywel Dda owned surgery, has the decision been made internally by Hywel Dda UHB or has the process been handled by an external agency or other HB?
- 6. If Hywel Dda made its decisions for its own owned branch Practices whether to remain open or close, why was this not managed by a different Health Board or external agency?
- 7. Has the branch surgery closure application process been adhered to on each occasion by the Health Board?

## Response:

- During the requested timeframe, Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) received one application to close a branch practice. An additional request for closure of a Managed Practice Branch was received; however, the General Medical Service (GMS) regulations that apply to independent contractors are not applicable to Managed Practices, and as such, this was not considered an application for closure.
- 2. The UHB received one request to close an Independent GP Contractor Branch Practice, and one Managed Practice Branch during the specified timeframe.
- 3. None of the applications were approved by the UHB.
- 4. Managed Practices are not bound by GMS regulations and therefore would not apply for closure.
- 5. Not applicable as GMS regulations do not apply.
- 6. Not applicable as GMS regulations do not apply.
- 7. Yes, GMS regulations were complied with when considering the application for the closure of the Independent GP Branch Practice.
