2. The name of the supplier of your onsite hospital pager system (to help manage patient flow)?

Onsite <u>hospital pager systems</u> allow the hospital to carefully manage patient flow throughout the patients visit.'

3. Does your Trust currently use remote monitoring?

4. The name of the supplier of your Remote monitoring system?
