Response:

Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) is unable to provide you with all the information requested, as it is estimated that the cost of answering your request would exceed the "appropriate level" as stated in the Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004. The "appropriate level" represents the estimated cost of one person spending 18 hours or (2 ½ working days) in determining whether the UHB holds the information, and locating, retrieving and extracting the information.

In order to provide you with all of the information being requested, the UHB would need to request and undertake a manual search of all patient records for the financial year 2019/20 months to identify any information that fulfils your request.

Therefore, the UHB is applying an exemption under Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOI), which provides an exemption from a public authority's obligation to comply with a request for information, where the cost of compliance is estimated to exceed the appropriate limit.

Under section 16 of the FOI, we are required, as a public authority, to provide advice and assistance so far as it is reasonable, to individuals who have made a request under the FOI Act and therefore can provide you with some of the information requested.

The Neurology Ambulatory Day Unit, based in Swansea Bay University Health Board (SBUHB) may hold a central record of and may be able to assist you further with your enquiry. We would therefore recommend that you redirect your request to the Freedom of Information Team in SBUHB:-
