Requested:

- 1. What antenatal advice does the trust routinely give to mothers about infant skincare including the bathing of babies?
- 2. What postpartum advice does the trust routinely give to mothers about infant skincare including the bathing of babies?

Response:

Hywel Dda University Health Board's (UHB) general advice for parents is to wait at least twenty-four (24) hours after birth before bathing the baby. However, parents can wait until the cord falls off before bathing the baby, should they wish to do so; this is to help the vernix soak into the skin for longer.

The UHB has recently completed the recording of a bath demonstration video, which is currently being edited. A copy of the script has been provided, at Attachment 1.
