- 3. The UHB confirms that it charges an on-boarding fee of £120.00.
- 4. The UHB confirms that the £120.00 fee covers the processing of the attachment, which includes Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks and Health Clearances.
- 5. The UHB confirms that international medical graduates are not paid whilst undertaking clinic attachments, and they only observe.
- 6. The UHB does not hold the requested information. Individual requests for clinical attachments are usually received by email.
