Please could you provide me with:

1. The number of people currently receiving support from Hywel Dda University Health Board's Covid-19 rehabilitation model for the long-term effects of coronavirus and persisting coronavirus symptoms (also known as 'long Covid').
2. The number of people in total who have received support from Hywel Dda University Health Board's Covid-19 rehabilitation model for the long-term effects of coronavirus and persisting coronavirus symptoms (also known as 'long Covid') since April 2020.
3. The number of patients referred to Hywel Dda University Health Board's Covid-19 rehabilitation model per month, since April 2020.
4. The number of patients discharged or released from Hywel Dda Health Board's Covid-19 rehabilitation model per month, since April 2020.

Response:

1. Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) confirms that one hundred and ninety four (194) people are awaiting or receiving support from the UHB's Long Covid-19 Syndrome Service.
2. The UHB's Long Covid-19 Syndrome Service commenced operation in September 2021. Since its commencement, the UHB confirms that two hundred and fourteen (214) people have received or are awaiting support, as at 22 March 2022.
3. The UHB provides, within the table below, the number of patients referred to the UHB's Long Covid-19 Syndrome Service, by month, from 1 September 2021 to 22 March 2022.
