Response:

- 1. Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) confirms that seven (7) permanent doctor vacancies have been offered and filled through recruitment agencies, during the period 1 January to 31 May 2021.
- The UHB confirms that no permanent roles that have been filled by agencies between during the period 1 January to 31 May 2021. Recruitment agencies are used to recruit hard to fill medical vacancies which are for an initial twelve (12) month period and are not permanent contracts.

However, the UHB can confirm that the offered positions recruited to, for 12 month contracts, was for five (5) were Specialty Doctors/Senior Clinical Fellows (Registrar level) and two (2) were Locum Consultant level.
