- 2. Has the Trust/organisation received a copy of the national MDO Victim Protocol (check name and insert date) and the date received from the Ministry of Justice?
- 3. Define the specific arrangements within your Trust/organisation to meet the requirements set in the national MDO Victim Protocol?
- 4. Is there a Trust/organisation policy/procedure for enacting the arrangements for Victim work set out in the national MDO Victim Protocol? Please can you provide a copy?
- 5. Confirmation of the resources dedicated to Victims (such as a lead post or designated team) to meet the requirements set out in the MDO Victim Protocol? Please describe the model and staffing resource?

## Response:

- 1. Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) confirms that it is responsible for the provision of inpatient and Community Mental Health services within its geographical area.
- 2. The UHB confirms that it has not received a copy of the national MDO Victim Protocol from the Ministry of Justice.
- 3. The UHB confirms that the arrangements set out in the MDO Victim Protocol are managed through the UK Government's Multi-Agency Public Protection Arrangements (MAPPA). The UHB attends MAPPA meetings, where any updates are provided, and Victim Liaison Officers (VLO) share the necessary information.
- 4. & 5. The UHB does not hold this information, as it does not make contact with victims; all victim sharing is via VLO and MAPPA.
