Response:

The National Health Service (NHS) in Wales is divided into seven (7) Health Boards, with Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) being one (1) of them and is an integrated Local Health Board responsible for the planning and provision of NHS healthcare services for people across its three (3) counties, Carmarthenshire, Ceredigion and Pembrokeshire.

The UHB has the following:

Four (4) main hospitals: Bronglais General in Aberystwyth, Glangwili General in Carmarthen, Prince Philip in Llanelli and Withybush General in Haverfordwest;

Seven (7) community hospitals: Amman Valley and Llandovery in Carmarthenshire; Tregaron, Aberaeron and Cardigan in Ceredigion; and Tenby and South Pembrokeshire Hospital Health and Social Care Resource Centre in Pembrokeshire;

Forty eight (48) General Practices (five (5) of which are managed practices), forty seven (47) dental practices (including three (3) orthodontic), ninety nine (99) community pharmacies, forty four (44) general ophthalmic practices (forty three (43) providing Eye Health Examination Wales and thirty four (34) low vision services) and seventeen (17) domiciliary only providers and eleven (11) health centres;

Numerous locations providing mental health and learning disabilities services.

As this information is already within the public domain, the UHB has applied an exemption under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FoIA).
