Response:

Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) confirms that it works in accordance with Royal College of Physicians (RCP) guidelines, which are linked to National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) guidance. The guidance can be accessed via the following link: https://pathways.nice.org.uk/pathways/osteoporosis

In addition, the UHB has guidelines for addressing possible Osteoporosis in Primary Care and Secondary Care; a copy has been provided in Attachment 1.

Patients are assessed using the Fracture Risk Assessment Tool (FRAX) which evaluates their FRAX score, patients are then offered appropriate treatment using a Bisphosphonate or Denusomab injection (dependant on their renal function and whether or not they have been on a Bisphosphonate previously). Any other specialist input is referred directly to the fracture liaison service.
