What are the payments made and who actually funds these payments?

**Response:**

Hywel Dda University Health Board confirms that GP practice staff are employees of the GP practice and so for those practices, the information is not held.

Employees of the UHB's managed practices are paid in accordance with the Agenda for Change (AfC) NHS Terms and Conditions of Service. Therefore, the duty of administering the flu jab would be deemed as one of their duties. The UHB is not aware of any additional payments made to employees for administering the flu jab.
