However, the UHB confirms that 277 patients were admitted to hospital that had received a positive COVID-19 test result up to seven (7) days prior to admission, during the period 1 November to 26 December 2021.

The UHB confirms that there were no patients admitted to hospital with Influenza that received a positive COVID-19 test result up to seven (7) days prior to admission, during the period 1 November to 26 December 2021.

The UHB, provides, within the table below, the number of patients admitted to hospital that were unvaccinated and those that received one, two, three and booster vaccinations, during the period 1 November to 26 December 2021.
