**Requested:**

1. The names of your outsourced teleradiology providers for:
  - Out of hours, emergency reporting (overnight reporting)
  - Routine Elective Reporting
2. Please provide the annual volumes for both 2023 and for 2024 sent to each provider, broken into the following:
  - Overnight Emergency
  - Routine Elective Reporting (MRI, CT)
  - Plain Film Reporting
  - Day time emergency reporting (1hr for example).
  - Split into each hospital within the Trust
3. Start date, duration and end date of any contracts with tele-radiology providers?
4. Was the contract procured via a framework (direct award), mini-tender, or ITT procurement process?
5. Who is the senior officer (outside of procurement) responsible for this contract?

**Response:**

1. Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) confirms that its outsourced teleradiology provider for Out of Hours (OOH), emergency reporting (overnight reporting) and routine elective reporting is Everlight Radiology.
2. The UHB provides, within the table below, the annual volumes outsourced to Everlight Radiology, by report type, during the 2023 and 2024 calendar years.

<b>Report type</b>	<b>2023</b>	<b>2024</b>
Day time emergency	12,765	11,972
Overnight emergency	13,672	13,103
Routine elective	17,123	16,816

3. The UHB confirms that its current outsourced teleradiology contract with Everlight Radiology commenced 1 November 2024 and has an end date of 31 October 2027, with an option to extend up to 31 October 2029 in two (2) twelve (12) month increments.
4. The UHB confirms that its current outsourced teleradiology contract with Everlight Radiology was procured by Direct award via a compliant NHS Supply Chain (NHSSC) Framework.
5. The UHB's senior officer, outside of procurement, responsible for this contract is Gail Roberts-Davies, Head of Radiology.
