4. The UHB confirms that it does not hold protected times to clear the backlog for Oncology, Cardiovascular treatments, Neurological treatments and Orthopaedic surgery due to the current precautions in place and the prevalence of COVID-19 in the community. However, the UHB is gradually restarting services at reduced capacity levels in line with guidance from the Royal Colleges, Welsh Government and Public Health Wales and are treating patients strictly in accordance to clinical prioritisation.

Additionally, some of the treatments for the Neurology, Oncology and Cardiovascular patients are provided by Swansea Bay University Health Bay and therefore, the patients would also be included within their wait times.
