Requested and response:

Overview: I would like to find out if the number of hospital staff accessing the board's staff mental health/counselling service is increasing, and why.

Please note: Please just answer questions one, two and three if the statutory time limit is reached after question three.

1. Does the hospital trust have a staff support and counselling service? If yes, what is it called? e.g. the Staff Support and Counselling Service

Please clarify whether the service is specifically for staff wanting support with work related issues, or whether staff can access the service for any personal issues unrelated to work.

Please confirm what is provided, e.g. six free counselling sessions

Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) has a staff support service, it is called the Staff Psychological Well-being Service, and it provides free, confidential psychological support to any Health board employee for work related and/or personal issues. Appointments are offered in all three counties, with bases at Prince Philip Hospital, Glangwili General Hospital and Withybush General Hospital, while locations in Aberystwyth and Lampeter are confirmed upon referral.

Initially, the staff member is offered a 'Resource Appointment' at which we explore options that may meet the individual's needs, with the possibility of then offering short term counselling, up to a maximum of 6 sessions. This is for mild to moderate level difficulties. Additional sessions may be agreed dependant upon individual needs, to support an employee through organisational processes such as returning to work after sickness absence, investigations, suspensions, grievances, dignity at work concerns etc.

2. How many staff members used the service in 2016, 2017 and 2018?
