- 3. Whether or not the Trust has been employing Doctors via MTI (Medical Training Initiative).
- 4. If Yes to Question 3, please provide a breakdown by the number of Doctors per month employed on MTI for the past 10 years across every grade (Consultant, Middle Grade, and Junior) and specialty (eg Emergency Medicine, Paediatrics, Radiology, etc.).

Response:

1. & 2. During the requested timeframe Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) offered SELR to two doctors, a Speciality Doctor in Emergency Medicine and a Speciality Doctor in Radiology.

Due to the high number of emergency middle grade vacancies within the UHB at present, SELR is currently being re-visited with three doctors going through the process at present.
