## Response:

Your request for information relates to Vestibular Migraines which are commissioned by Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs).

CCGs are a feature of the NHS in England. Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) is part of NHS Wales and is an integrated Local Health Board responsible for the planning and provision of primary, community and in hospital services, based on the needs of the local community across three (3) counties.
