Requested:

1. I am looking to obtain both daily water usages (cubic metres) and daily sewage volumes (cubic metres) for the following 7 hospital sites, over the following 3 week periods:

- a. University Hospital Llandough - Cardiff and Vale University Health Board
- b. Morriston Hospital - Swansea Bay University Health Board
- c. Bronglais Hospital - Hywel Dda University Health Board
- d. Ysbyty Glan Clwyd Hospital - Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board
- e. Ysbyty Gwynedd Hospital - Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board
- f. Wrexham Maelor Hospital - Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board
- g. Royal Glamorgan Hospital - Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board

- May 14 - 20, 2023
- June 11-17, 2023
- July 9-15, 2023

2. I am also looking to obtain both daily water usages (cubic metres) and daily sewage volumes (cubic metres) for the following 3 hospital sites, over the following 3 week periods:

- a. Ysbyty Glan Clwyd Hospital - Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board
- b. Ysbyty Gwynedd Hospital - Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board
- c. Wrexham Maelor Hospital - Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board

- December 10-16, 2023
- January 7-13, 2024
- February 4-10, 2024

If daily water usages and daily sewage volumes are not available, monthly volumes would be acceptable, or annual volumes (only if this is all that is available). If an annual volume is provided, please be clear on the dates this period covers (i.e., calendar year, or financial year with corresponding dates).

Response:

Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) does not hold information for all Health Boards in NHS Wales and is therefore unable to provide you with all of the information requested. The UHB can only provide the information it holds.

However, in response to question 1c, the UHB provides within Attachment 1, its water consumption for Bronglais General Hospital (BGH) in cubic metre per hour (m³/h), as measured by Welsh Water's 15-minute automated logger, for the three (3) periods requested.

The UHB does not hold the sewage volumes, as discharges are not metered. However, the sewage discharge is deemed by Welsh Water to be 82% of the water consumption volume.
