Requested:

I am requesting copies of the following documents referred to in correspondence from the Chair of Hywel Dda University Health Board dated 23 June 2026 regarding healthcare provision at Ysgol Heol Goffa:

1. The Quality and Safety Deep Dive report relating to nursing provision and healthcare support at Ysgol Heol Goffa.
2. The risk assessment(s) undertaken in relation to healthcare provision, nursing support, medicines management and delegated healthcare tasks at Ysgol Heol Goffa.
3. The Equality Impact Assessment screening referred to in the Chair's letter.
4. Any entries on corporate, directorate, operational or Board-level risk registers relating to:
 - Ysgol Heol Goffa;
 - Healthcare provision within the school;
 - Nursing provision;
 - Medicines management;
 - Delegated healthcare tasks undertaken by education staff.
5. Any benchmarking information, reports or analyses referred to in the Chair's letter comparing school nursing provision at Ysgol Heol Goffa with similar settings elsewhere in Wales.

Response:

1. Hywel Dda University Health Board (UHB) provides a copy of the Quality and Safety Intelligence Group Deep Dive: Heol Goffa onsite Nurse Provision report, at Attachment 1.
2. The UHB provides a copy of the risk assessment undertaken on 1 January 2026 relating to the healthcare needs of children attending Ysgol Heol Goffa, at Attachment 2.
3. The UHB provides a copy of the Equality Impact Assessment (EqIA) relating to the risk assessment provided in response to question 2, at Attachment 3.
4. The UHB has undertaken a search of its Datix Incident and Risk reporting system, and no entries have been identified relating to Ysgol Heol Goffa and specifically, the following within the school:
 - Healthcare provision
 - Nursing provision
 - Medicines management
 - Delegated healthcare tasks undertaken by education staff.
5. The UHB does not hold the requested information, as the benchmarking was undertaken verbally in an All-Wales Peer meeting and this has not been formally signed off by each individual Health Board as at the date of your request.

However, there is a plan to map this formally via the All-Wales Senior Leads Children's Community Nursing Services Forum by September 2026, to inform a wider review of Welsh Government guidance.
