
As part of the recovery proposals for the HB, Welsh Government (WG) capital funding has been approved for the demountable solution at Prince Phillip Hospital totalling £2.513m. Further work is on-going to develop this proposal.

Further funding may become available as the year progresses through additional WG approvals, review of VAT recoveries, asset disposals and slippage on existing schemes.

The sales of Neyland Health Centre and Cardigan Health Centre have now completed with proceeds of £0.089m and £0.300m respectively. These disposals will be available for utilisation in the DCP – the prioritisation of these have not yet been undertaken.

Expenditure Profile Forecast

A forecast expenditure profile for 2021/22 is shown in the table below.



Work is ongoing to develop the cash flow forecast for the year. Expenditure on the Discretionary Programme is based on last year's actual expenditure profile where funds have not yet been allocated to specific projects or items. This will be further refined as funds are allocated and further information on expenditure profile becomes available. Expenditure to the end of May was £1.912m.

Financial Risks

Women & Children Phase II (GGH)

There is an estimated additional cost implication for the scheme of £2.233m because of the implementation of social distancing legislation as a consequence of COVID-19. These costs have not yet been agreed with the Supply Chain Partner. Following the review undertaken by NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership (NWSSP)-Estates of these costs, they have agreed that they are reasonable and have advised WG accordingly. The Health Board (HB) is actively seeking agreement from WG that these costs will be reimbursed.

Project Updates

Women & Children Phase II (GGH)

A number of risks to project-critical paths have been identified by the Project Manager and Supply Chain Partner over the coming months which could impact on the completion date and cost of the scheme. Consequently, the forecast project costs have risen by £0.352m (an increase in scheme outturn from £29.499m to £29.851m since the last reporting period). The largest contributor to this increase has been an assessment of the cost implication of a 12-week delay due to replacement of floor screed. There is a possibility that an additional DCP contribution will be required in 2022/23 to mitigate this increase in forecast costs. A review of equipment, non-works and IT forecast expenditure is currently underway to assess whether there are any opportunities to mitigate additional cost pressures which are arising on the scheme.

Ongoing profiling of resource usage is being undertaken with the Cost Advisors for the scheme and regular progress updates are provided to WG and NWSSP-Estates.

Project Bank Accounts

The Withybush Fire Precaution project is due to start on site in June. Due to the size of the project WG requirements around Project Bank Accounts (PBAs) are applicable, with expected project expenditure being in excess of £2.0m. The proposed account offered by the Supply Chain

Partner's current bank has been reviewed by the HB and the arrangements proposed satisfy WG requirements; therefore once funding approval has been given by WG, the request to set up the PBA will be formally initiated.
