An Open Letter & Petition to Hywel Dda Health Board ahead of your decision to be taken on Thursday 25 July on the future of Meddygfa Tyddewi / St Davids Surgery

Annwyl Aelodau Bwrdd / Dear Board Members,

1. We completely understand the decision of Dr Stephen Riley to relinquish his current status of sole partner. Dr Riley is a highly respected and highly valued member of our community, and we thank him for his years of service, and look forward to having him continue as one of our GPs, employed by the Health Board, until his well-earned retirement in 2028.
2. We have no objection to the administration of the surgery being taken over by the Health Board and combined with the administration of Meddygfa Solfach / Solva Surgery. Combining administration makes economic sense, enabling more resources to be spent on treating patients.
3. **We are completely opposed to the closure of the current surgery on Heol Newydd / New Street in the centre of Tyddewi / St Davids. Any future plans for primary care in the area must include a physical GP surgery in the city.** An accessible surgery is a vital amenity for everyone, and especially for the most vulnerable. It is essential for people including mothers with young children, teenagers, people with disabilities, older people who have given up driving, those who cannot afford the money or the time to travel elsewhere, and for the large number of visitors to the city throughout the year. Closing our surgery will further denude the services accessible to people who live here. Our banks have closed, our library is threatened, our bus services are vulnerable. Every service that closes makes our community less and less viable, forcing people to move elsewhere.
