The framework involves applying a Red/Amber/Green (RAG) weighted score against the risk matric criteria. The following weighting has been applied:

- High/Red -10
- Medium/Amber 5
- Low/Green 1

The outcome of the risk assessment matrix score has been set as follows:

- High risk of unsustainability > or = 80
- Medium risk of unsustainability >55 -79
- Low risk of unsustainability <55
