CT(24)03 AUDIT WALES 2023 AUDIT PLAN – HYWEL DDA HEALTH CHARITIES

Mr Huw Thomas introduced the Audit Wales Audit Plan – Hywel Dda Health Charities report, highlighting on page 6 information around risks, with the audit having identified a significant financial statement risk, the Risk of Management Override. This risk is common, being present in all organisations. A response has been developed, and work has been undertaken with Audit Wales to provide evidence of actions taken in mitigation. Also on this page are details of the financial statements' materiality, which totals £25,080. This is low, and is worked within.

Mr Huw Thomas wished to thank the Finance and Corporate Governance teams for their contribution, together with colleagues in Audit Wales for their positive collaboration during the audit process.

CT(24)04 HYWEL DDA HEALTH CHARITIES ANNUAL REPORT AND ACCOUNTS 2022/23

Mr Huw Thomas welcomed the positive position presented in the Hywel Dda Health Charities Annual Report and Accounts 2022/23. He thanked donors, fundraisers and volunteers for their continued support, emphasising that income raised provides vital support for purchasing equipment, etc. Ongoing fundraising efforts exist for the Bronglais General Hospital Chemotherapy Unit, and the Hydrotherapy Pool at Pentre Awel. Members heard that there have been losses on the investment portfolio of approximately £600k, although these are not cash losses. Income on investments comprises approximately £400k. Total funds sit at £11.9m for 2022/23, which has enabled purchases totalling £0.8m; this in the context of significant schemes such as those mentioned above. Ms Delyth Raynsford, Chair of the Charitable Funds Committee, wished to recognise the contribution of local communities and staff to the success of Hywel Dda Health Charities. Funds raised make a significant difference to the experience of patients, carers and families, and Ms Raynsford expressed her sincere gratitude to all.

Ms Eleanor Ansell advised that the Audit Plan was provided for information and as part of the audit documentation, which was separate to that for the HDdUHB Annual Accounts. The materiality is set out within the Audit Plan, and an ISA 260 has been issued. Ms Ansell was pleased to report an unqualified audit opinion. There were no uncorrected misstatements, and some corrected misstatements.

The Corporate Trustee **APPROVED** the Hywel Dda Health Charities Annual Report and Accounts 2022/23.
